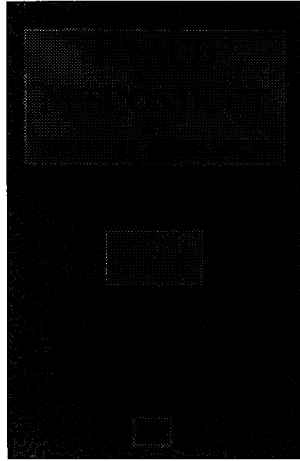

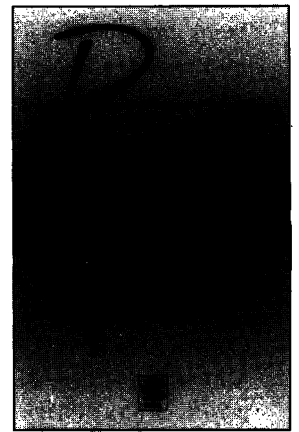

# Rights and Responsibilities of Doctors

Doctors have rights and responsibilities and duties and powers which require them to do or not to do certain things in certain circumstances. Doctors' actions, as well as being governed by their professional code, are also regulated by a variety of legislation with which they must comply. Examples include the various Public Health Acts, the Misuse of Drugs Act, the Human Fertilisation and Embryology Act, the Data Protection Act, the Access to Health Records Act, and so on.
