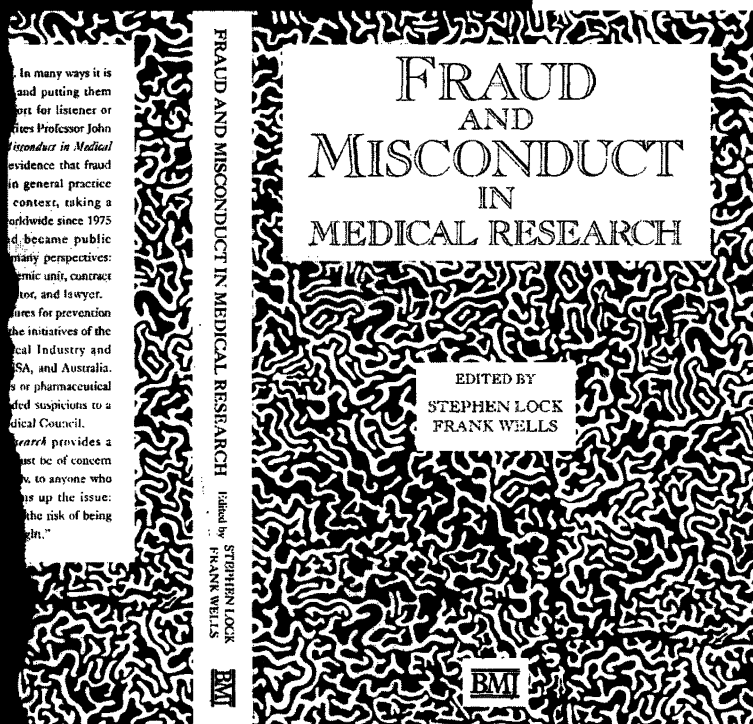
THE UNACCEPTABLE FACE OF SCIENCE

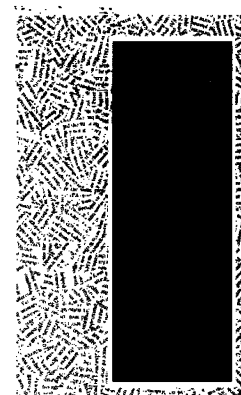
