

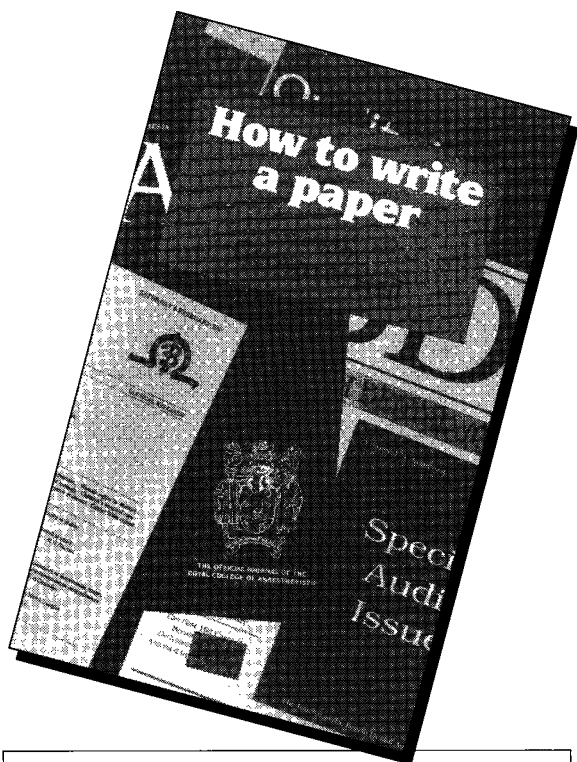
# WANT TO GET YOUR PAPERS PUBLISHED?

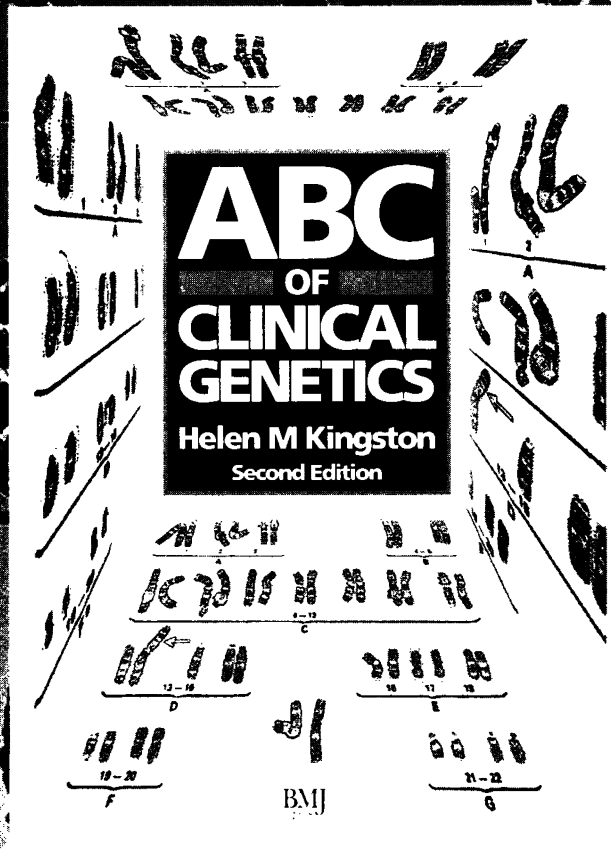

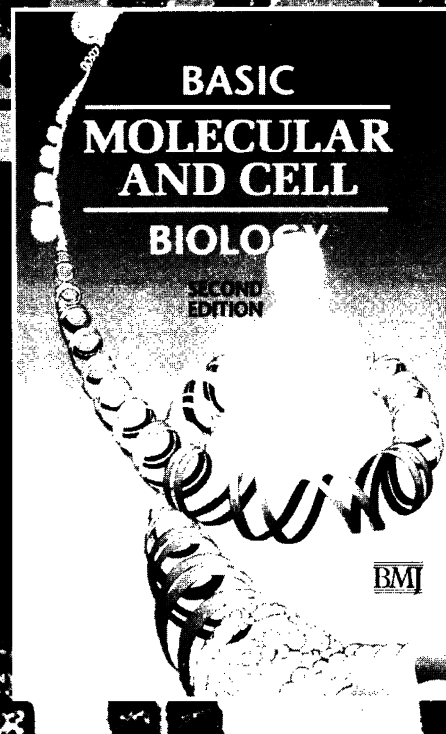
