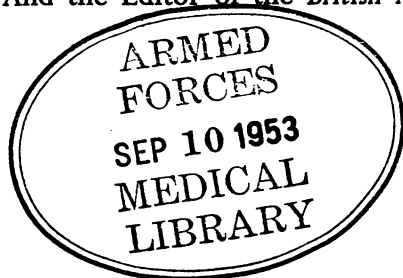

The Society for Endocrinology has embarked on the publication of a series of "Memoirs of the Society for Endocrinology." These will be issued separately from time to time. It is intended to use them as records of the Proceedings of the Society's conferences, for special reviews, or for any other purposes in which separate publication appears to the Editorial Board of the Society as being preferable to an article, or a series of articles, in the *Journal of Endocrinology*.

Memoir No. 1, which has just been published, is a record of a conference on "The Thyroid Gland,"

which took place at the end of February. The memoir contains a full discussion of the histology, biochemistry, and endocrinology of the thyroid. It is now available at a cost of 5s. (exclusive of postage) from the Pitman Press, Bath. Memoir No. 2, dealing with the proceedings of a symposium, held in May, on "The Determination of Adrenocortical Steroids and their Metabolites," should be available in September, 1953. It is hoped that about three or four such memoirs will be produced each year.
